

Cricket Blitz Score Sheet Instructions

This how-to-score guide is here to get you through your first Cricket Blitz game. Once you've scored one game you'll find the score sheet very easy to use.

Before the game begins you should enter the names of the teams playing.

In the 'innings of' box you should enter the team which is going to bat.

Batters names go into this column.

At the beginning of each over the bowler's name needs to be written in the 'bowler' box.

You write what happened after each ball in the box corresponding to the batsmen on strike, i.e. if batsman one scores 1 run on the first ball of the over you write '1' in this box

After each over you should tally up the total number of runs scored in the over.

If a bowler bowls an extra in the final over they have to re-bowl that delivery. The 'extra delivery' box is the place to record what happens with the extra balls.

An extra is either a wide (when it's too far away for the batter to reach) or a no-ball (when the ball bounces more than two times or is over the batters waist on the full).

The 'runs scored' column is where you tally up the runs a batsmen scored.

The 'wickets lost' column is where you tally up the times a batsman got out.

The 'total runs' column is where you take away the runs each batsman lost from their 'runs scored'. Batsman lose 3 runs per 'out'.

'Total partnership' is where you add up the runs each pair scored while batting.

'Team Total' is where you add up the total number of runs the batting team scored.
