



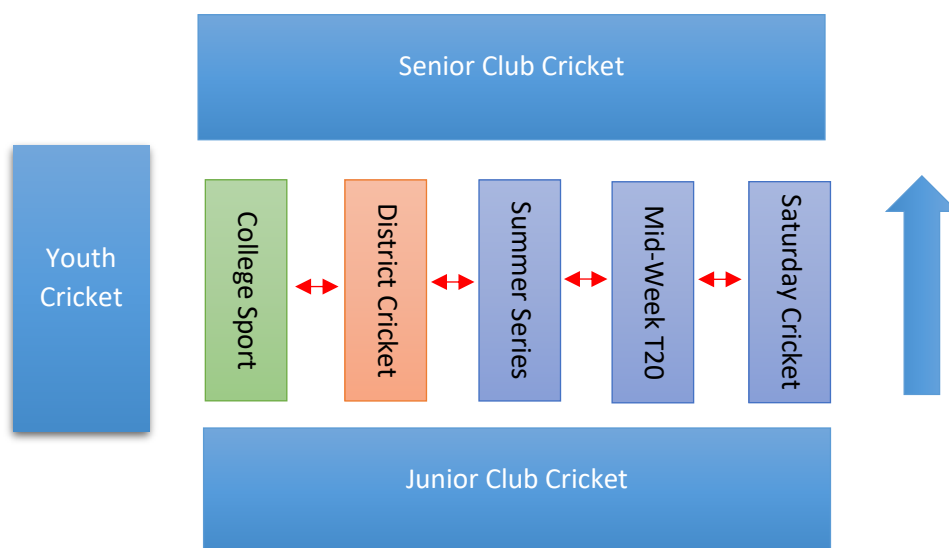
Youth Cricket Competition Overview 2020/21
